

PRIVACY ACT

Informative note and request for consent to handle personal information according to articles 13 & 23 of legislative decree 196/03 "Code regarding the protection of personal information").

For the intents and purposes of legislative decree 196/03 "Code regarding the protection of personal information" we hereby inform you that the handling of personal information – provided by you – will be made in accordance with the principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency, in order to guarantee your privacy and more in general your rights.

To this end, in order to enable you to suitably assess the way in which your personal information will be handled, we would like to remind you that handling means the collection, registration, organization, preservation, processing, changing, selection, extraction, comparison, use, communication, diffusion, cancellation and destruction or the combination of two or more of said operations.

Said information will be handled for corporate purposes, connected or instrumental to our business activities.

For example, we may use your information:

- ~ to fulfill legal obligations
- ~ for operational, managerial, administrative or fiscal purposes
- ~ to be able to provide services agreed by means of a contract
- ~ to make an insertion in the yearbook
- ~ to insert pictures on the web site

Information will be handled using instruments that can guarantee its protection and confidentiality, including electronic means able to store, manage and transmit the same information to external parties if necessary and with an undertaking on your part to promptly inform us of any corrections and or updates.

The nature of the information and the handling of such require your consent in writing, which may be given by completing the section below.

Please note that any refusal to provide us and/or to enable us to handle personal information could make it impossible for us to carry out the activities for which said information is required.

We would also like to inform you that with regard to the aforesaid handling, the rights under art. 7 of legislative decree 196/03 may be exercised.
